#### **Pop Song**

Students will study pop song and manipulate, refine and adapt existing and new musical material to create a final arrangement of a song.

### Variations

Students will study theme and variations, and employ different techniques to create their own variations piece..

## Film Music

Students learn about the conventions of film music over the last hundred years. They perform and create leitmotifs to represent characters within films.





Students will perform and create music using the techniques devised by Claude Debussy, including scales from different times and places, and chordal techniques.

#### Blues

Students learn to develop their improvisation skills using the traditions and conventions of Blues Music.


Form and Structure

Students will perform and create music to set structures, learning how to use structure to compose music of increasing complexity.



#### **African Drumming**

Students will explore the cyclic drumming patterns in African music and work in groups to produce performances that include improvisation.



Students will study music inspired by art. They will perform and create music inspired by art work.





Students will apply their skills from Term 1 to create descriptive music using the elements of music, and create a pentatonic melody and ostinato.
