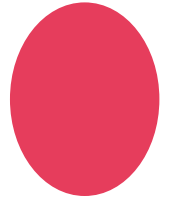

Your child's first day at Fairlands in September...

- Children will spend their first day with their tutor and will participate in various 'ice-breaker' games and activities, and another tour of the school.

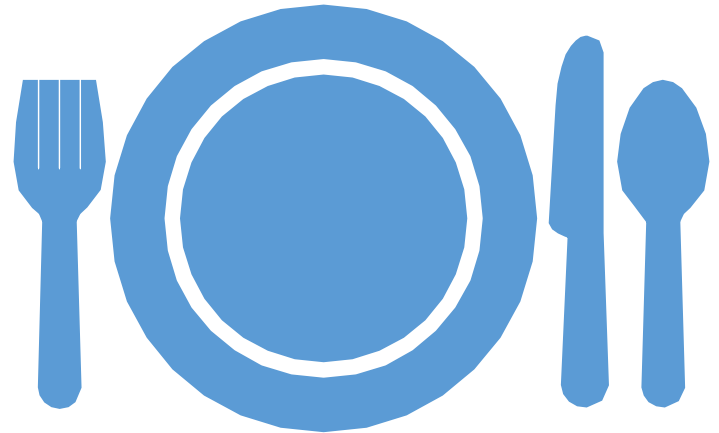
Time-table

Lunches

- **Packed lunch.**
- **School dinners** can be paid for via Parent Pay. You can preload money to your account, your child will pay using their finger print.
- **Forgotten meals** – Your child will still choose their meal and use their finger print, it will appear in red on their account.



Playtime snack

- We strongly advise that your child has a **snack** at breaktime. They will be feeling hungry by 11:20 and will need the energy to get through lesson three.
